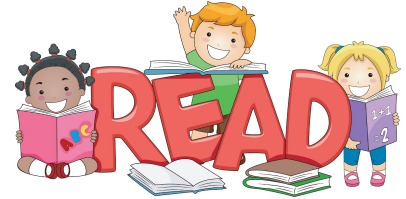
Summer 2020 - Reading Assignments

Students Entering Kindergarten

There is no reading requirement. Please just enjoy books with your child!



Students Entering First Grade

These books may be read to, with, or by students:

Read Chicka Chicka Boom Boom by Bill Martin, Jr. and John Archambault

Read your favorite book and bring it to school during the first week

Bring these books to school in September, and be prepared to do activities about the book.

Students Entering Second Grade

Read Last Stop on Market Street by Matt De La Pena

Bring this book to school in September, and be prepared to do activities about the book.

Students Entering Third Grade

Read Freckle Juice by Judy Blume

Bring this book to school in September, and be prepared to do activities about the book.

Students Entering Fourth Grade

Read Roll of Thunder, Hear My Cry by Mildred Taylor

Bring this book to school in September, and be prepared to do a book report the first month.

Students Entering Fifth Grade

Read No Talking by Andrew Clements

Students may bring these books to school if they wish but it is NOT required.

Students Entering Sixth Grade

Read A.k.a Genius by Marilee Haynes

Read Turtle in Paradise by Jennifer Holm

Students may bring any of these books to school if they wish but it is NOT required.

Students Entering Seventh Grade

Read Powerless by Matthew Cody

Bring book to school in September, and be prepared to do activities about the book.
